



Dr. Chelsea Fiduccia Clinic Director, the Steven A. Cohen Military Family Clinic



Chelsea Fiduccia (she/her) is a clinical psychologist and the Clinic Director at the Steven A. Cohen Military Family Clinic at Metrocare. Dr. Fiduccia has been with the Cohen Clinic since 2016, previously serving as Clinician and Assistant Clinic Director. As Clinic Director, she is responsible for leading an interdisciplinary team within the clinic and instilling the overlapping missions of Metrocare and Cohen Veterans Network into the clinic's daily work serving post-9/11 veterans, service members, and their families. Dr. Fiduccia frequently liaises with the Cohen Clinic's community partners and helps ensure the sustainability of the clinic through grant-funding, philanthropy, and billing

revenue. In addition to administrative duties, Dr. Fiduccia maintains clinical involvement through a small clinical caseload and/or supervision of psychology trainees. As the spouse of a Navy veteran, Dr. Fiduccia is grateful for the opportunity to give back to the military and veteran community. Dr. Fiduccia has been honored for her work by Cohen Veterans Network as the recipient of the Founder's Award in 2024 and by the Society of Psychologists in Leadership, naming her the 2024 Early Career Woman Psychologist in Leadership.

Dr. Fiduccia earned a BA from the University of Rochester and a PhD in clinical psychology from the University of North Texas. Prior to joining the Cohen Clinic at Metrocare, Dr. Fiduccia worked and trained in both government and non-profit sectors providing mental health services to individuals with severe mental illnesses and individuals involved in the legal system. She also developed research and assessment expertise in forensic psychology, including evaluation of response styles and Miranda rights.
